THE PREDESTINATION AND ELECTION

FOR YOU: Being predestined and elected have been the will of the Lord and the bible calls “people” as the One he loves as his people, to live the eternal life, here on earth to enjoy his promises. It is the choice of God and only by His free will. Discussing predestination is a controversial topic and subject in the churches, mainly in traditional ministries. However, we at Cristo Vive church feel capable and have sufficient authority to keep preaching and abetting always and everywhere. We are obedient to the call and choice that we have been made to preach the truths of the gospel. The election and predestination is the gospel and God’s absolute sovereignty. It is the basic foundation of Christianity. Predestination and election began before the world was created. It was not because we deserve, not by the work we do, not by marketing our own qualities, not by personal faith or the excellence of life that one has before God, but by the explicit desire of God, the purpose of his will and of course, By his great mercy. God predestines, calls, justifies and glorifies whom he so decides. In fact, he has done all that with whom he wanted. From before the foundation of the world was built it was like that. This is, in short, the doctrine of predestination.

God Has Elected and Predestined His Sons Before the World was Created

- He chose us in him before the creation of the world. (Ephesians 1:4);
- He has saved us and called us to a holy life before the beginning of time. (2 Timothy 1:9);
- God chose you as firstfruits. (2 Tesselonians 2:13);
- God prepared his objects of mercy in advance for his glory. (Romans 9:23);
- God formed us and knew us before the womb. (Jeremiah 1:5);

— God calls the generations from the beginning. (Isaiah 41:4).

To Be Predestined and Chosen for Salvation is God's will and is regardless of our Free Will

— We are predestinated and elected by Gods will. (Ephesians 1:11);

— You did not choose me, but I chose you. (John 15:16);

— God predestined us for adoption to sonship. (Ephesians 1:5);

— Does who have been chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father. (1 Peter 1:2);

— I was found by those who did not seek me; I revealed myself to those who did not ask for me. (Romans 10:20).

Belief in Jesus Christ Is Only For Those Who are Appointed – Predestined to Eternal Life

— When the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and honored the word of the Lord; and all who were appointed for eternal life believed. (Acts 13:48)

THE TWO SEEDS

“And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.”

Genesis 3:15

FOR YOU: The purpose of this study is to have a clear understanding that in this world there are two seeds: the sons of God predestined to salvation, and the sons of Evil who were destined to perdition.

Since Sin has Become Part of This World, God Wanted to Separate His Good Seeds from the Bad Seeds who belong to Evil.

- To justify His wrath, God should kill Lucifer for induced Adam and Eve to disobey Him, but He couldn't because His is love, He couldn't contradict his own creation. So God has allowed that an inside a woman's womb the seed of perdition was sown. And, from Cain all his descendants were destined to perdition. (Genesis 3:15).
- Cain was destined to perdition. (Genesis 4: 4-5).
- The men who didn't have pre-existence had their existence after Cain birth. They are sons of perdition, whose father is Evil. From Cain descend all children of perdition: Pharaoh, Judah, Herod, etc. (1 John 3:12).
- The Bible tells us that there are people who don't have their names written in the book of life. Children of perdition are those who are not chosen or neither called to be part of His kingdom, to salvation. They were conceived by an evil seed and their end perdition.

Not Everyone is Predestined to Salvation – Some Of Them Are Destined For Condemnation

- “First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn.” (Matthew 13: 29-30)
- “... objects of his wrath – prepared for destruction?” (Romans 9:22)
- “... for not everyone has faith”. (2 Thessalonians 3:2)
- “They stumble because they disobey the message — which is also what they were destined for”. (1 Peter 2:8)
- Born to perish. (2 Peter 2: 12-14)
- “They didn’t not really belong to us”. (1 John 2:18-19)
- Ungodly people who were condemned. (Jude 4:11)

The Sons of Evil Will Not Believe in Jesus Christ And Will Not Bear Good Seeds.

- The wicked will continue to be wicked. None of the wicked will understand, but those who are wise will understand. (Daniel 12:10)
- A good tree cannot bear bad fruit (Sons of God), and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit (Sons of the Evil). (Matthew 7: 15-20)
- “You do not believe me!” (John 8:37-47)
- Their names were not written in the Book of Life. “I did tell you, but you do not believe. The works I do in my Father’s name testify about me, ²⁶ but you do not believe because you are not my sheep.” (John 10:24-26)

The Children of Evil Don’t Have their Names Written in the Book of Life

- “... all whose names have not been written in the Lamb’s book of life, the Lamb who was slain from the creation of the world”. (Revelation 13:8)

- "... The inhabitants of the earth whose names have not been written in the book of life from the creation of the world will be astonished when they see the beast, because it once was, now is not, and yet will come." (Revelation 17:8)

The Bible Tells us About the Existence of Two Worlds:

1. The World of God – Sons of God

The word "world" in the context below, it refers to the world of elected people (Oikumene).

- "but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved. ¹⁴ And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come." (Matthew 24: 13-14)
- "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)
- "that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation." (2 Corinthians 5:19)
- "He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world." (1 John 2:2)

2. The World of the Evil – Sons of the Evil

The word "world" in the context below, it refers to the world of the sons of perdition (Ayom).

- "the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you." (John 14:17)

- “ While I was with them, I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me. None has been lost except the one doomed to destruction so that Scripture would be fulfilled.¹³ “I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my joy within them. ¹⁴ I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. ¹⁵ My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one.” (John 17: 12-15)
- “They are from the world and therefore speak from the viewpoint of the world, and the world listens to them.” (1 John 4:5)

The Parables About the Two Seeds

- The wheat and the weeds. (Mathew 13: 24-43)
- The good and the bad fish. (Matthew 13: 47-50)
- The wise and the foolish virgins.(Matthew 25: 1-13)
- The parable of the sower. (Mark 4: 1-20)

Judas Iscariot Was Always the Son of the Evil

- “Then Jesus replied, ‘Have I not chosen you, the Twelve? Yet one of you is a devil!’” (John 6:70)
- “Jesus answered, “Those who have had a bath need only to wash their feet; their whole body is clean. And you are clean, though not every one of you. ¹⁸ “I am not referring to all of you; I know those I have chosen. But this is to fulfill this passage of Scripture: ‘He who shared my bread has turned against me.’” (John 13: 10,18)

The word of God proves that there are two kinds of people, two kind of seeds, and two opposite descents: the Son of God and the son of the Evil. There are those who are predestined to salvation and those who are predestinated to perdition. We only can believe and predestination

if we believe that there's two seeds. The enemy revolts when these truths are revealed because it goes against the lies he preaches in the Churches for so many years, have said that we are equal before God and everybody has the same rights to salvation.

The bible tells a history about the two descents: God's and Evil's, wheat and weeds, sheep and goats, Abel and Cain, saved and condemned, and so on. There are people in the world who are not descent enough to be saved, and most of the times they have an apparent repentance virtue to God's words that calls everyone, even the "weeds" sometimes. The Antichrist can go to church, make friends, sing, clap hands, give offerings, but the bible says that they will never be converted. The good seed comes because of God's calling, He brings them. Now, the weeds come because of their needs, and the same way they come they can turn their backs to God as if nothing had never happened. But who belongs to God, for instance, can't ever be separated from Him. Who is a good seed receives blessings, protection, baptism, a seal, and no matter what happens they will never be apart from God. If it weren't for that we would be serving a powerless God, or a God that saves one but not the other? Does a man, His own creation have more power than Him? Whatever He wanted, he did. His is the sovereign God. His will will always rules above all. It's important for us to know that there's nothing new in this message, but has been hidden in the bible for many years, and it pleases God to reveal it to us.

In our ministry we only preach what is in the holy scriptures, because is the only word that educates, disciplines, calls, admonishes, and gives us a clear understanding about our Savior Jesus Christ. There are certain verses that we are not capable to understand, because of the lack of spiritual knowledge that we're missing in us, that has always kept us from understanding what the verses are telling us, the words were not clear, but now, God has started to tear the veils from our eyes so we can see His revelation and His words.

The Wolf and The Lamb

— “ I speak the truth in Christ—I am not lying, my conscience confirms it through the Holy Spirit—² I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. ³ For I could wish that I myself were cursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my people, those of my own race,⁴ the people of Israel. Theirs is the adoption to sonship; theirs the divine glory, the covenants, the receiving of the law, the temple worship and the promises. ⁵ Theirs are the patriarchs, and from them is traced the human ancestry of the Messiah, who is God over all, forever praised! Amen. ⁶ It is not as though God’s word had failed. For not all who are descended from Israel are Israel. ⁷ Nor because they are his descendants are they all Abraham’s children. On the contrary, “It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned.” ⁸ In other words, it is not the children by physical descent who are God’s children, but it is the children of the promise who are regarded as Abraham’s offspring. ⁹ For this was how the promise was stated: “At the appointed time I will return, and Sarah will have a son.”¹⁰ Not only that, but Rebekah’s children were conceived at the same time by our father Isaac. ¹¹ Yet, before the twins were born or had done anything good or bad—in order that God’s purpose in election might stand: ¹² not by works but by him who calls—she was told, “The older will serve the younger.”¹³ Just as it is written: “Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated.”¹⁴ What then shall we say? Is God unjust? Not at all! ¹⁵ For he says to Moses, “I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion.” ¹⁶ It does not, therefore, depend on human desire or effort, but on God’s mercy. ¹⁷ For Scripture says to Pharaoh: “I raised you up for this very purpose, that I might display my power in you and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth.”¹⁸ Therefore God has mercy on whom he wants to have mercy, and he hardens whom he wants to harden ¹⁹ One of you will say to me: “Then why does God still blame us? For who is able to resist his will?” ²⁰ But who are you, a human being, to talk back to God? “Shall what is formed say to the one who formed it, ‘Why did you make me like this?’”²¹ Does not the potter have the right to make out of the same lump of clay some pottery for special purposes and some for common use? ²² What if God, although choosing to show his wrath and make his power known, bore with great patience the objects of his wrath—prepared for destruction? ²³ What if he did this to

make the riches of his glory known to the objects of his mercy, whom he prepared in advance for glory—²⁴ even us, whom he also called, not only from the Jews but also from the Gentiles?” (Romans 9:1-24)

A Wolf Can Dress up Like a Lamb But He Can't Behave Like One

- The lamb shows his spiritual fruits. “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness.” (Galatians 5:22)
- Living according the Spirit. “Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. ⁶The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace. ⁷The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God’s law, nor can it do so. ⁸Those who are in the realm of the flesh cannot please God.⁹ You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ.” (Romans 8: 5-9)
- A wolf won't remain. “They went out from us, but they did not really belong to us. For if they had belonged to us, they would have remained with us; but their going showed that none of them belonged to us.” (1 John 2:19). “Make a tree good and its fruit will be good, or make a tree bad and its fruit will be bad, for a tree is recognized by its fruit. ³⁴You brood of vipers, how can you who are evil say anything good? For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of. ³⁵A good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and an evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him. ³⁶But I tell you that everyone will have to give account on the Day of Judgment for every empty word they have spoken. ³⁷For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned.” (Matthew 12: 33-37)

THE ETERNAL SALVATION

“For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.”

FOR YOU: This study aims to give Christians a true knowledge about their salvation obtained by Christ on the cross, and it can't be voided by anyone or anything in this world. Your salvation is forever!

God Promised us Eternal Life Before Creating The Foundation Of The World

- “Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ to further the faith of God’s elect and their knowledge of the truth that leads to godliness—² in the hope of eternal life, which God, who does not lie, promised before the beginning of time,³ and which now at his appointed season he has brought to light through the preaching entrusted to me by the command of God our Savior.” (Titus 1:1-3)
- “... because God chose you as firstfruits to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth.” (2 Thessalonians 2:13)
- ⁹ He has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time.” (2 Timothy 1:9)

Those Who Believes in Christ Will Never be Lost

- “That everyone who believes may have eternal life in him.”¹⁶ For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.” (John 3: 15-16)
- “Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life.” (John 5:24)
- “...whoever eats this bread will live forever...” (John 6:47-51; John 6:58)

Christ is able to save completely. If a Man is Unfaithful He Still Remains Faithful

- “... whoever comes to me I will never drive away.” (John 6:37)
- “And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all those he has given me, but raise them up at the last day.” (John 6:39)
- “I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish.” (John 10:27-29)
- “...He is able to save completely...” (Hebrews 7:22-25)
- “That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet this is no cause for shame, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him until that day.” (2 Timothy 1:12)
- “To him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy.” (Jude 24)

Sin Cannot Void your Salvation

- “The one who is victorious will, like them, be dressed in white. I will never blot out the name of that person from the book of life, but will acknowledge that name before my Father and his angels.” (Revelation 3:5)
- “But we do not belong to those who shrink back and are destroyed, but to those who have faith and are saved.” (Hebrews 10:39)
- “Then will the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped. ⁶ Then will the lame leap like a deer, and the mute tongue shout for joy. Water will gush forth in

the wilderness and streams in the desert.⁷ The burning sand will become a pool, the thirsty ground bubbling springs. In the haunts where jackals once lay, grass and reeds and papyrus will grow. ⁸ And a highway will be there; it will be called the Way of Holiness; it will be for those who walk on that Way. The unclean will not journey on it; wicked fools will not go about on it. ⁹ No lion will be there, nor any ravenous beast; they will not be found there. FOR YOU: The purpose of this study is to show you the importance of the two types of human nature that exists in the life of every Christian: the human flesh and the spiritual nature. Only the word of grace can deeply cut and separate these two natures, so every Christian can identify the sin in his body and the perfection in his spirit. (Hebrews 4:12)

The Human Flesh Came from Adam. Spiritual Nature Came From Jesus Christ

- Adam formed many sinners, Jesus Christ has formed many righteous. (Romans 5:19)
- Adam brought transgression, Jesus the gift of life. (Romans 5: 15)
- Adam brought condemnation, Jesus justification. (Romans 5: 18)
- Trough Adam many have died, and trough Jesus many have been saved forever.
(Romans 5:15)

The Flesh is Faithful to Sin But the Spirit is Faithful to God

- Our mind serves God but the human flesh to the law of sin. (Romans 7:25)

- Death is at work in us (the flesh), but life is at work in you (the Spirit). (2 Co 4:12)
- The body is subject to death because of sin, but the Spirit gives life. (Romans 8:10)

All Born-Again Believers Still Have a Sinful Body

- Saved without removing the filth of the flesh. (1 Peter 3: 21)
- No sin will reign in your mortal body. (Romans 6:12)

FINAL WORDS – The sin in your body can't tarnish your life but it can bring you consequences from your actions. You are born with an incorruptible seed, and because you have a divine seed in you don't go through life sinning. You are a winner.

THE LAW AND THE GRACE

“By calling this covenant ‘new,’ he has made the first one obsolete; and what is obsolete and outdated will soon disappear.”

Hebrews 8:13

FOR YOU: The purpose of this study is to clearly define the difference between the two pacts: law and grace, and the two alliances, so we can not only serve God in the ways He delights, but also produce good deeds for His glory.

THE LAW – The Old Covenant Was For the Flesh

- Apart from the law the sin was dead. (Romans 7:8)
- The law was brought in so that the trespass might increase. (Romans 5:20)
- The law is holy and the commandment is holy, righteous and good. (Romans 7:12)
- Nobody can fulfill. (Romans 8:3; John 7:19; Acts 7:53)
- For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it. (James 2:10)
- The law was our guardian until Christ came that we might be justified by faith. (Galatians 3:24)
- The law is made not for the righteous but for lawbreakers and rebels. (1 Timothy 1:9)

— The law is not based on faith. (Galatians 3:12)

THE GRACE – The New Covenant Is For The Spirit

— In the grace, the sin has no dominion over you. (Romans 6:14)

— In the grace, we are dead to sin. (Romans 6:2)

— In the grace, we are justified from sin. (Romans 6:7)

— In the grace, we have been released from the law. (Romans 7:6)

— The new covenant is established on better promises. (Hebrews 8:6)

FINAL WORDS – It is only by faith apart from the deeds of the law that you can live a life in grace, in a way that pleases God. The One who lives in you through His spirit, testifies that you are a son of God, and He is the sustainer and guarantor of the new covenant.

THE RUDIMENTS OF DEAD WORKS

“So, my brothers and sisters, you also died to the law through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God.”

Romans 7:4

FOR YOU: The modern church is based on ordinances and rudiments of the flesh that has prevented it from achieving its perfection. These ordinances are the reason for many conflicts and multiple divisions of church throughout the years. And, it's all because of the lack of knowledge. The old system or the old rules known as religious tradition have established twisted teachings that have transformed the preaching of good news into a catechism of fear. Our calling is to teach people knowledge so through this knowledge people can be set free of the rudiments and be confident about their own relationship with God. Tradition stops people from progressing and growing. Every tradition is flawed and blocks our walk with God. What we need to do as reformers of the “Last Protestant Reformation” is to let people know that we don't have to follow Christ from his *old flesh* period anymore. Christ during his days of flesh went through of all kind of sufferings to fulfill the Mosaic Law, but today He is the Risen Christ!

Paul Made a Call For Us To Move Beyond The Elementary Principles of the Doctrine of Christ (The Rudiments) and To Walk Towards Perfection

— There are more superior and deeper doctrines than the Christ's doctrine when being in his flesh, fulfilling the law. (Hebrews 6: 1-3)

— Christ has brought us freedom. (Galatians 5:1)

Jesus During his Flesh Period Has Called Up Jews

— Jews preaching to Jews. (Matthew 10: 5-6)

Jesus Resurrected Has Called Gentiles

— For the Gentiles, God has raised someone specific. (Acts 22: 21)

The Rudiments Were a Shadow of Things Until The Time of The New Order For All Things Come

— Food and regulations until the time for the new order only. (Hebrews 9:10)

— No one can judge because of the rudiments. (Colossians 2: 16-17)

— We died with Christ to the elemental spiritual forces of this world. (Colossians 2: 20-23)

— Let us move beyond the elementary teachings about Christ, and be taken forward to maturity. (Hebrews 6:1)

The Rudiment of Baptism in Water Was a Shadow of The True Baptism in the Holy Spirit

— The baptism in the water it was to redeem the sins. (Mark 1:4)

— The baptism of the Holy Spirit puts the believer dies to sin. (1 Peter 2:24; Romans 6:1-14)

— The baptism in water was a shadow that disappeared. (John 3:25-36; Matthew 3:11-12)

— Jesus didn't baptize in water. (John 4:2)

— God did not call Paul to baptize. (1 Co 1:17)

— We are all baptized in Christ by the Holy Spirit. (Galatians 3:27; 1 Co 12:13)

- Paul has dismissed the baptism in water from the list of the church. (Ephesians 4:5)
- The anointing received from Him remains in our lives forever. (1 John 2:20-27)

“Since you died with Christ to the elemental spiritual forces of this world, why, as though you still belonged to the world, do you submit to its rules.” Colossians 2:20

Fasting – In past years Christians used fasting as a reason to make requests to God. The spirit that practices fasting is the law; fasting is something that comes from Catholic Church because the sacrifice is part of the Roman church, the novenas, the absence of food, etc. The evangelical traditions absorb the sacrificial offering where people isolate themselves; spending hours kneeling, deprive themselves from wellbeing, sacrificing their lives for poor vows, celibacy, etc. This is not the sacrificial offering described in the bible! We don't believe in fasting as a source of power or spiritual improvement. Nowadays evangelicals are fasting to create a spiritual experience, fables and tales, using this argument to say that the fast is the weapon against Satan. But the only weapon against him was the sacrifice Jesus Christ made on the Cross. The Pharisees also fasted to have spiritual experiences and use it as a reason to make them proud.

Fasting Was a Jewish Custom

- Jesus disciples didn 't fast. (Luke 5:33)
- Jesus replies to Pharisees. (Luke 5:34)
- John Baptist's disciples followed the rites of law. (Matthew 9:14)
- Jesus tied fasting to suffer, sadness, grief, pain and crises. Those are some of the reasons why the Jews used to fast. (Matthew 9:15)
- “We cannot confuse the old Judaism system with the grace of God. The old covenant can't resist the power of the new covenant, and for the other hand, the new covenant cannot accept the mixture between what was old and what is new. Or we follow the grace of God or the old Mosaic law. There's no place for both at the same time”.

Matthew 9:16-17

The fast that we've chosen is the biblical model

- Jesus wants us to break with everything that afflicts our souls. This is the true fasting that God has command it. (Isaiah 58: 5-7)

The lack of knowledge makes us to think that there's a kind of demon that only goes ways if we pray and fast

- Jesus didn't have yet defeat the Evil, and nor put the demon in a chain for his final trial. The word "fasting" is not included in the original Greek. (Hebrews 2:14; Jude 6; Mark 9:29)

Apostle Paul's Fasting Was Part of His Suffering for The Love of Gospel

- Paul has been arrested, been beaten, been stoned, was shipwrecked, been worked much harder, been flogged. He have known hunger and thirst, and have been cold and naked. (2 Co 11: 21-23)

Other verses as references:

Titus 1:14; 1 Timothy 1:4; 1 Timothy 4: 8-9; Galatians 3:10; Hebrews 13:9; Galatians 2:16; Romans 14:23, Romans 11:6)

- "So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer." (2 Corinthians 5:16)

Let's Evince What the Bibles Called as Dead Works: The Dead Works Are

Every Action Devoid of Life, and Therefore, it Can add Nothing to a Christian's Life, Because it's Produced by The Flesh. For Instance:

- Saturday – Is the Jewish day for resting. Our resting day, for the other hand, our *Sabbath* day is Jesus. (Colossians 2:16; Hebrews 4: 9-10)
- Food and Feed – In this world there's only one dignify thing to be pursued: God's knowledge. (Colossians 2:16; Hebrews 9:10)
- Jewish celebration
- Washing feet was proof of humbleness (John 13: 1-20)
- Parameters and collar clerical
- Ecclesial clothing and stoles
- Sick unction
- Laying of hands
- Sacrifices and rites – vows, shave heads, purification (Acts 21: 23-24)
- Corporal exercises – fasting, vigil, spend hours kneeling (Colossians 2:16-23)
- Celebration dates – Christians, Easter, Pentecost, Jewish feasts (Colossians 2:16)
- New Moon celebration – creates superstitions
- Crucifix with Christ symbolized
- Extreme unction – has no spiritual value; it's a Roman ritual
- Ribbons – superstitions
- Oil unction, candies, rue, soaps, unction clothing
- Sulphur, blood, chains, salt, rose petals, tissues, water of Jordan, week of Gideon, Isaac, Josaphat, Moses, David – they are all spurious ways to trade with the christians, annulling the grace of God and depreciate the new covenant.
- Commandments of men – banning haircuts, nail polish, makeups, waxing etc.

FINAL WORDS – Our ministry was created to bring people knowledge. And, through it, we can all be free of the rudiments and be confident about our election in Christ. That is why in every service preached you gradually grow more in the knowledge and grace. When we study the bible to learn more from God and His scriptures we are not only sedimenting our spiritual lives but becoming more mature, spiritually. It is important to remember that Judaism was a religion of elementary things. But Christianity is deeper than the Jewish law, and Paul's teachings came to print a new character of spiritual maturity in our lives, surpassing the legalistic principles.

FOR YOU: The apparent and temporary defeating for Christians is the product of their lack of knowledge to know their positions in Jesus Christ and the machinations of Satan.

Before Christ

- Santan accused God’s sons in the present of Jehovah. (Job 1: 6,12)
- We used to live following the ways of this world. (Ephesians 2:2)

After Christ

- Christ has deprived principalities and the powers, and has triumphed above them.
(Colossians 2: 14-15)
- He breaks the power of who holds the power of death. (Hebrews 2:14)
- He has been hurled down the accuser of our brothers and sisters. (Revelation 12:10)
- He has kept in darkness, bound with everlasting chains for judgment on the great Day.
(Judas 1:6; 2 Peter 2:4)

Can a Christian be Possessed by Demons If The Holy Spirit is in Them?

- Definition of *Possession* – someone without freedom that lives under a supernatural power authority. Domain of demon.
- Definition of *Possessed* – a person completely controlled by an evil spirit; be available to Satan; be domain by Satan.
- Definition of *Oppression* – prolonged cruel or unjust treatment or control; the state of being subject to unjust treatment or control; mental pressure or distress; humiliation; reduction of forces, torment.
- The one who was born of God keeps them safe, and the evil one cannot harm them. (1 John 5:18)

The Bible is Clear When It Explains That There Is Only One God

- The Lord is one. (Deuteronomy 6: 4-9)
- The Lord our God, the Lord is one. (Mark 12:29)
- See now that I myself am he! There is no god besides me. (Deuteronomy 32:39)
- Him only. (John 5:44)

The Names of God Were United in Jesus Christ

- Brought unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ. (Ephesians 1: 9,10)
- For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form. (Colossians 2:9)

The Son of God Who Had Walked The Earth Was God Himself

- For us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders.
“And he will be called...” (Isaiah 9:6)

one may deceive you by fine-sounding arguments. ⁵ For though I am absent from you in body, I am present with you in spirit and delight to see how disciplined you are and how firm your faith in Christ is. ⁶ So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, ⁷ rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. ⁸ See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ. ⁹ For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form.” (Colossians 2:1-9)

— “For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles— ² Surely you have heard about the administration of God’s grace that was given to me for you, ³ that is, the mystery made known to me by revelation, as I have already written briefly. ⁴ In reading this, then, you will be able to understand my insight into the mystery of Christ, ⁵ which was not made known to people in other generations as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to God’s holy apostles and prophets. ⁶ This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus.” (Ephesians 3: 1-6)

The Bible Says that Christ Seats at the Right Hand of God. In This Context, The Right Hand Means: A Maximum Power, The Full Power of God

- “Jesus said: And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven.” (Mark 14: 60-65)
- God exalted him to his own right hand as Prince and Savior that he might bring Israel to repentance and forgive their sins. (Acts 5:31)
- The Lord’s right hand has done mighty things! (Psalms 118: 15-18)

In the book of Revelation The Bible Tell Us About a Throne Set in Heaven Where Someone is Seated

- A throne set in heaven. (Revelation 4:2; Revelation 7: 9-11)

FINAL WORDS – The bible describes that there is only one true God, and it refers to Jesus Christ as the true God (1 Corinthians 5:20). Also the bible mentions that His name is above every name (Philippians 2:9-11), and refers to Him as the only Sovereign Lord (Judah 4).
