THE LAW – The Old Covenant Was For the Flesh

- Apart from the law the sin was dead. (Romans 7:8)
- The law was brought in so that the trespass might increase. (Romans 5:20)
- The law is holy and the commandment is holy, righteous and good. (Romans 7:12)
- Nobody can fulfill. (Romans 8:3; John 7:19; Acts 7:53)
- For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it. (James 2:10)
- The law was our guardian until Christ came that we might be justified by faith. (Galatians 3:24)
- The law is made not for the righteous but for lawbreakers and rebels. (1 Timothy 1:9)

— The law is not based on faith. (Galatians 3:12)

THE GRACE – The New Covenant Is For The Spirit

— In the grace, the sin has no dominion over you. (Romans 6:14)

— In the grace, we are dead to sin. (Romans 6:2)

— In the grace, we are justified from sin. (Romans 6:7)

— In the grace, we have been released from the law. (Romans 7:6)

— The new covenant is established on better promises. (Hebrews 8:6)

— We have been saved by grace. (Ephesians 2:8)

— The grace is testified in your heart, and it's not vain. (Hebrews 13:9)

— And if by grace, then it cannot be based on works. (Romans 11:6)

In the New Covenant the Law is Written in Your Heart and Christ in You is the Hope of Glory

— Written on our hearts. (2 Corinthians 3:2-3)

— No having the law they are a law for themselves. (Romans 2:14)

— Move you to follow my decrees. (Ezekiel 36: 26-27)

The Law Was a Ministry of Death But The Grace Is The Ministry of Life

— He has made us competent as ministers of a new covenant. (2 Corinthians 3:6)

— The ministry of death came with glory. (2 Corinthians 3: 7,9,10)

— The ministry of the spirit remains. (2 Corinthians 3:11)

- We have gained access of grace by faith. (Romans 5:2)

- He has made perfect forever those who are being made holy. (Hebrews 10:14)
- He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness. (Colossians 1:13)
- Set free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:2)
- Justified, hallowed and redeemed. (1 Corinthians 1:30)
